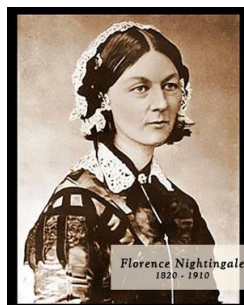
Sports Day
