A cross-party group of MPs from the three largest parties in the UK Parliament have come together to bring forward the Abortion (Cleft lip, cleft palate and club foot) Bill. The Bill will change the law to clarify that cleft palate, cleft lip, and club foot are not grounds for abortion in the UK. **PACT (Prison Advice and Care Trust)**: Christmas 2020 is going to be a very difficult time for many people. About 80,000 men in prison and some 4,000 women will be 'locked down' in one of the 117 prisons in England and Wales, and with very minimal family contact. Some 89,000 children will have at least one parent in prison at this special time. PACT has established a Christmas Gift Scheme to help strengthen links between imprisoned parents and their children. In past years the Scheme has involved gift parcels but this year, for obvious reasons, it is simpler to ensure that a BOOK TOKEN FOR £10 is sent in a Christmas card from the parent to the child.
