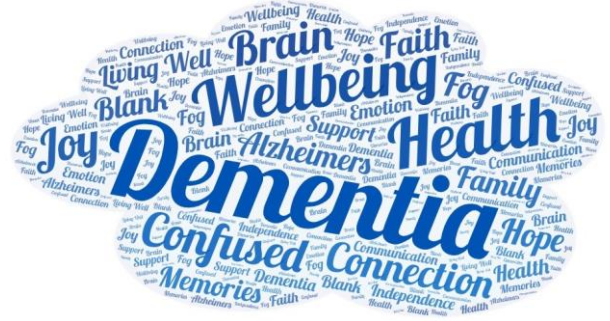


Dementia Action & Awareness
