- It is really important that children continue to read as much as possible, therefore, your child will bring home six reading books, one for each week of the holidays. There are a range of questions and activities provided in the back of each book, which are really useful for helping to support your child's understanding of the text. Please keep the books together in the pack and return them as a full set in September.
- Information has been provided on Seesaw regarding the Leeds Library Summer Reading Challenge 'Calling all Wild Readers'. This is a great way to encourage children to read a wide range of books.
- Children will also bring home the statutory spelling list for their year group or flashcards of key words and phonics sounds.
- Please ensure your child continues to access TT Rockstars, where there will be regular competitions scheduled over the Summer. It is really important that children have a strong, confident knowledge of the times tables facts.
- The Government established Oak National Academy have created a wide range of free Summer learning support resources. These resources cover a range of subject areas including English, Maths and Science and include video clips and downloadable resources.
